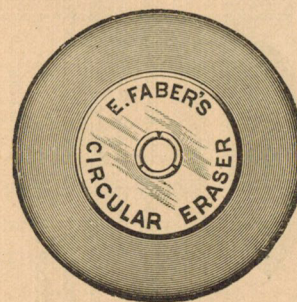
SMALL, No. 2. ACTUAL SIZE.

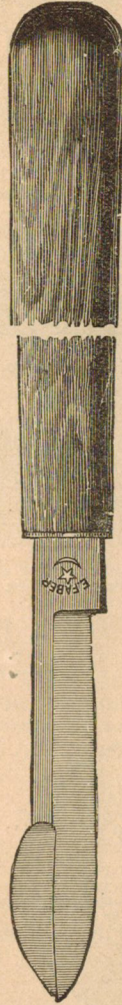

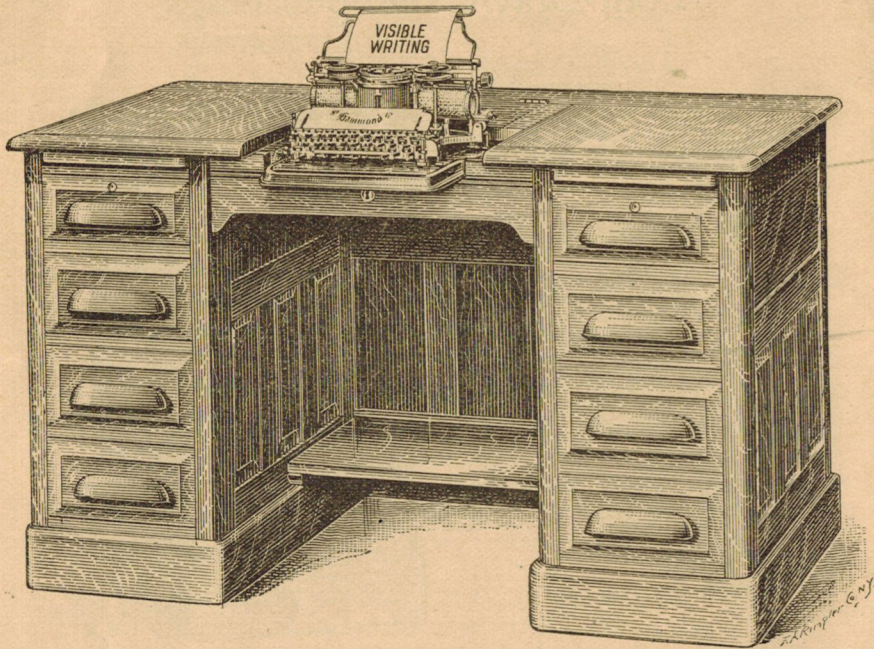

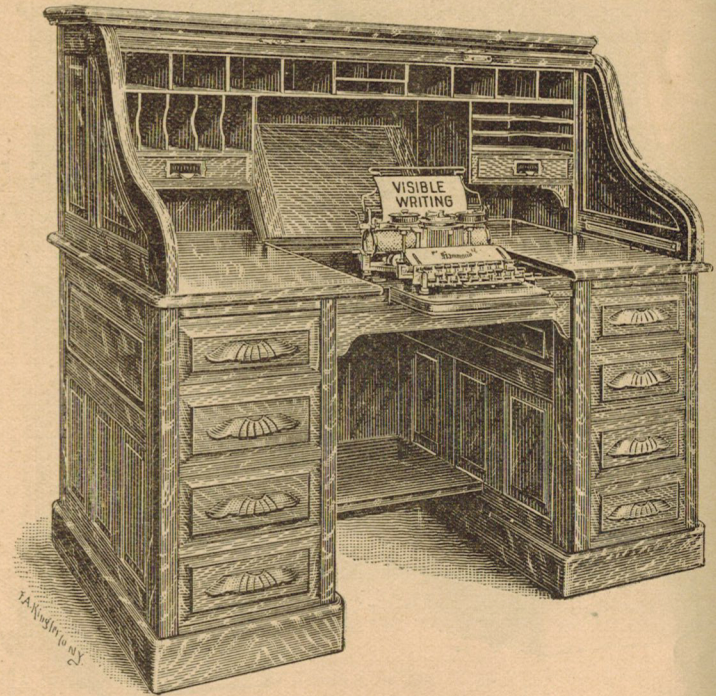

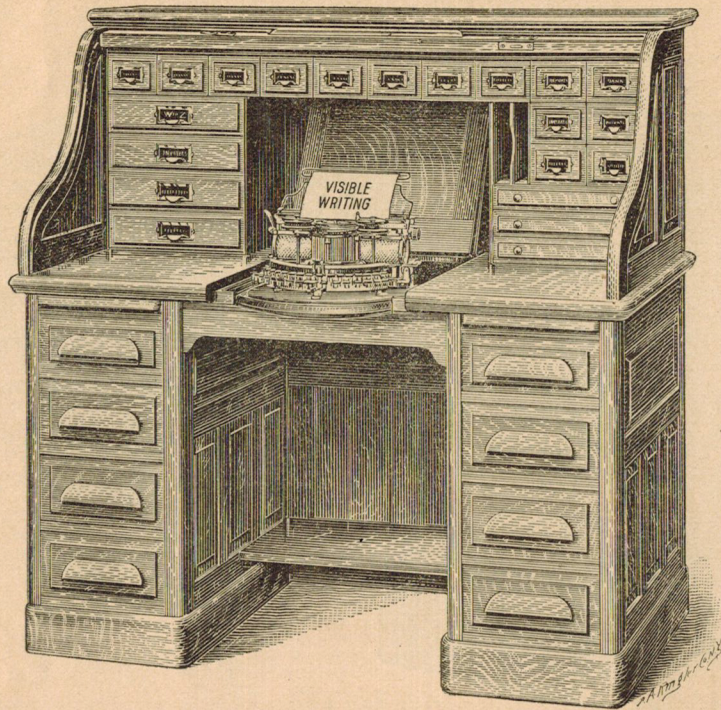

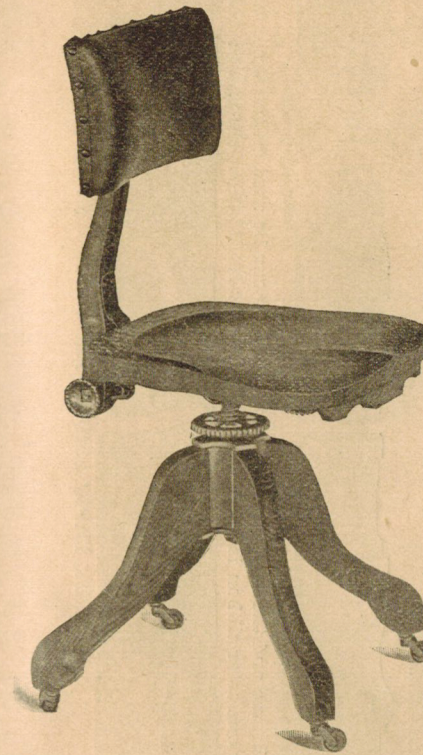

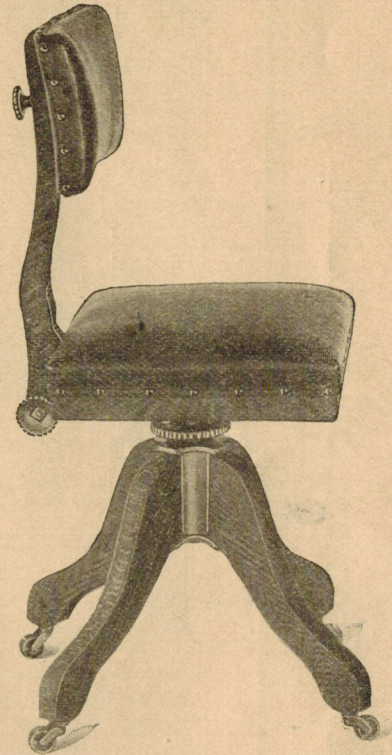


STYLE 24. Cane seat, adjustable cane back with spring, oak, rubbed finish. Price, . . . \$5.25

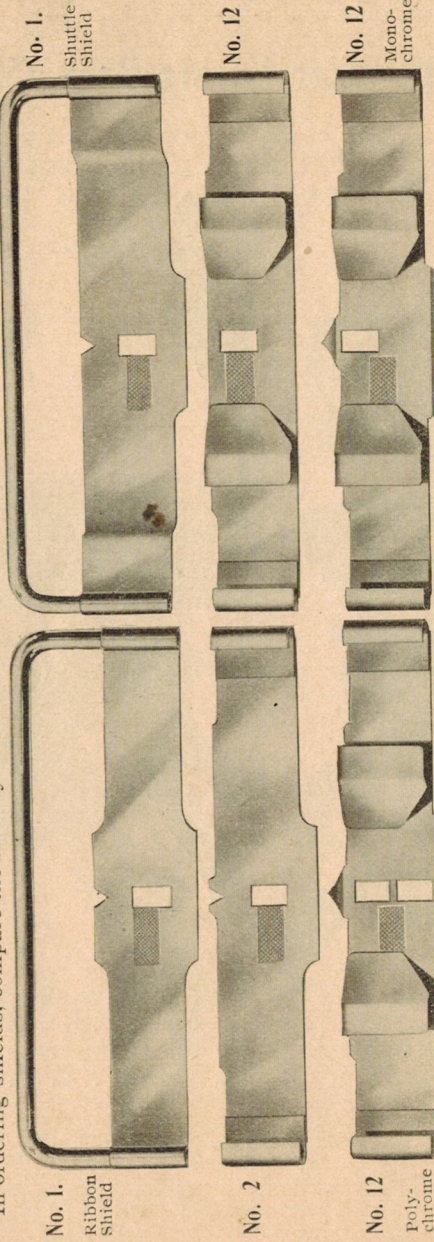
